

(KIDS) is a non-profit organization with tax exempt status whose sole mission is to help children and teens. We provide children and teens with necessary clothing and personal hygiene items when they are unexpectedly removed from their homes (i.e. entering foster care, entering a shelter, left homeless, home fires), as well as any child/teen in need.



The KIDS concept was created to help these children and teens through a difficult transition time in their life. Within the scope of the KIDS's mission statement, "we exist so that no child will go without," we provide 5 sets of clothes, coats, hats, mittens and gloves, undergarments, socks, shoes/boots, beds (as available), and age appropriate items such as deodorant, diaper/wipes, toothpaste/brush, comb/brush, shampoo, and other personal hygiene items.



A stuffed animal and a small toy are always included for the children.

It is impossible to put a number on how many children/teens are in foster care, relative care (grandparents raising grandchildren), shelters, etc. This number changes constantly. There are also those children who are brought to emergency shelters due to their families becoming homeless due to eviction, domestic violence, or house fires. The police. the court, and Children's Protective Services are also responsible for temporary emergency care of our children. With our economic conditions, many families just cannot afford to clothe their children

KIDS is based in St. Clair County and is committed to the children and youth who are in specific need. The Economic Opportunity Committee, The Family Independence Agency and

other community agencies have been consulted and support this project and our mission.
